BIG IDEA:

When the Roman Empire collapsed, the eastern half, known as the Byzantine Empire, became the dominant power in the Mediterranean World for a time. While it retained many aspects of the old Roman Empire, the Byzantine Empire changed to become its own unique culture, embracing more of the influences that came out of the eastern Mediterranean, eventually becoming cut-off from the development of the West. Under constant pressure from surrounding powers, the Byzantine Empire eventually shrank and declined until the 15th century, when it ceased to exist all together.
